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INTRODUCTION

A total of 1138 requests were received in 2012. This report summarizes the activity of the Insect Identification Laboratory at Virginia Tech for 2012. The laboratory is located in 205A Price Hall. Eric Day, Lab Manager, and Doug Pfeiffer, Extension Entomologist, Department of Entomology manage the lab. Charlotte Oliver, Tree Dellinger, and Olivia McCraw also worked in the Lab in 2012.

Of the samples received in 2012, 83% of the samples, 965 out of 1138, requested control recommendations.

Also from the samples received in 2012, 25% of the samples, 274 out of 1138, were forwarded from the Plant Disease Clinic, managed by Mary Ann Hansen and Elizabeth Bush. The remaining 75% were sent directly.

Specimens are identified and recorded in the lab, then if necessary sent for control recommendations and additional comments from Extension Entomologists who handle particular commodity groups. All specimen data are entered into the Insect I.D. Lab computer database on the Virginia Tech mainframe computer. The database greatly facilitates sorting and storage of the information. Some of the records were sent via microcomputer to the Cooperative National Plant Pest Survey and Detection Program (USDA, APHIS, PPQ). We at Virginia Tech acknowledge support provided by this program.

Whenever possible insects are identified to the species level. Common names are used where possible because of their wide recognition. To facilitate mailing insects and insect damaged plant specimens to the lab, local offices of Virginia Cooperative Extension are provided with Insect Identification and Diagnosis Request forms (form 444-113), alcohol vials, and mailing tubes. 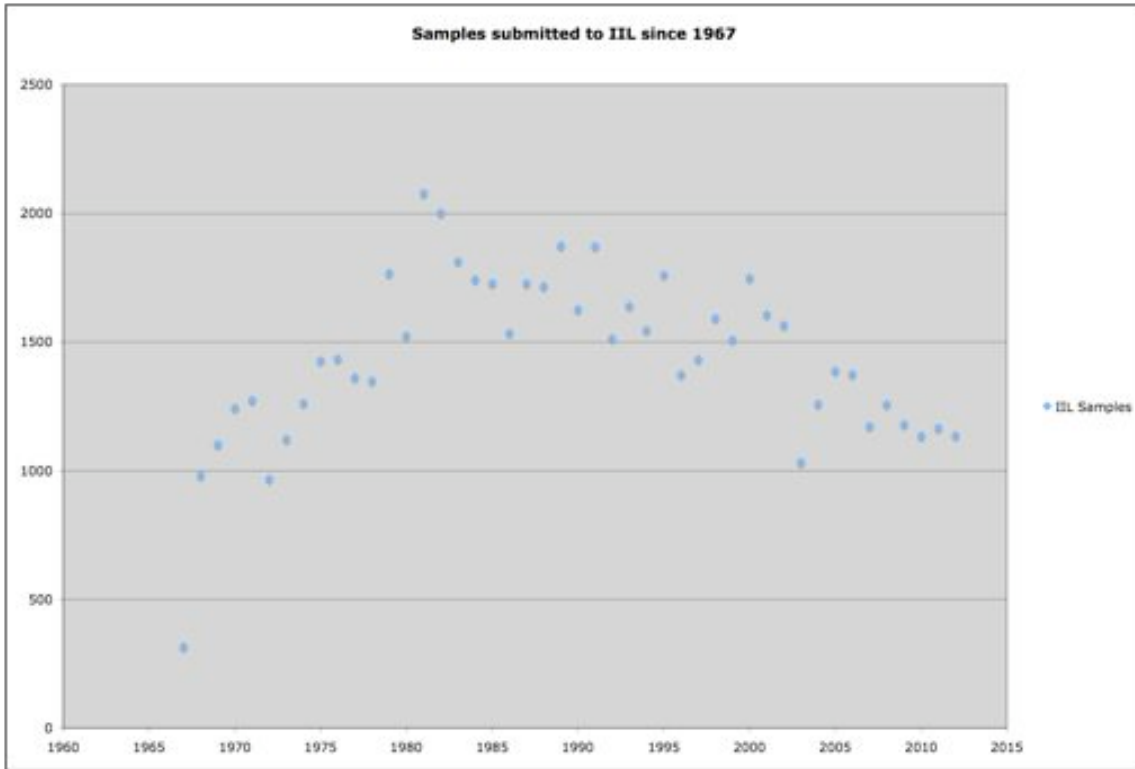
